

Listed below are the essential job functions and criteria for membership, as well as a step-by-step explanation to assist you as you go through the application process. If at any time you have questions, please contact us.

Volunteer Firefighter

Essential Job Functions:

- Attend and actively participate in monthly business and training meetings. (*Meetings: typically Tuesday nights at 7:30 pm at a Glynn County fire station*)
- Participate in monthly station duty.
- Maintain a state of readiness for emergency response.
- Provide protection of life and property.
- Respond to emergency calls for fire suppression, medical assistance, hazardous materials incidents, motor vehicle accidents and other emergency situations when notified.
- Suppress, control and extinguish fires.
- Performs forcible entry, search, rescue, & extrication of victims.
- Perform salvage, overhaul and cleanup activities.
- Drive, operate and monitor a variety of fire and emergency vehicles according to level of training. (*Must meet minimum Glynn County requirements*)
- Administer first aid, artificial respiration, life support or other medical care according to level of certification.
- Assist career department personnel with inspections of buildings for pre-incident plans, fire hazards and compliance with fire prevention ordinances.
- Prepare and complete various forms and reports.
- Participate in organized community service activities.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Reports to Fire Lieutenant or volunteer officer

Minimum Education, Training and Experience:

- High school diploma or GED is required.
- Must be at least eighteen (18) year of age.
- Must pass background check.

Required Certificates/Licenses & Residency:

- Valid Georgia driver's license. (*Class "A non-commercial" driver's license is required to operate Department apparatus*)
- Be a Resident of Glynn County.

- Uniforms, Turnout gear, and Equipment.
- All the training necessary, for you to become proficient at the job functions.
- Worker's compensation coverage while engaged in department activities.
